Ref: Insurance – Legal Expenses

Dear Colleague,

I would like to draw your attention to the above policy which has been acquired by Scouting Ireland as part of its overall insurance cover for its members in this case for Scouters. The acquisition of this policy continues the ongoing process by Scouting Ireland to continually review its insurance policies and where identified and practical to do so acquire additional cover or amend existing cover, so as to support and resource its membership in this area.

The legal expenses policy provides for legal defence (up to the limit of the indemnity) in respect of the insured person's (Scouter) legal rights if an event arising from the insured person's work as a member of Scouting Ireland leads to the insured person being prosecuted in a criminal court. The terms of the policy will also defend in certain instances the insured person's (Scouter) legal rights if an event arising from the insured person's work as a member of Scouting Ireland leads to the insured person being the subject of a civil action.

Given the nature of the policy and the two different legislation frameworks within Ireland, it is necessary to identify a separate Legal Expenses policy for each such legislative framework;
