**Category:**

- Chief Scout's Commendation of Honour**  
Awarded for an active part in rescue operations or for Scouting under difficulties
- Bronze Honour Award**  
Awarded for rescue operations in hazardous conditions or for Scouting under difficulties
- Silver Honour Award**  
Awarded for rescue operations at personal risk to the rescuer or for Scouting under difficulties
- Gold Honour Award**  
Awarded for rescue operations at extreme risk to the rescuer or for Scouting under difficulties
- Scouting Ireland Community Award**  
Awarded to Non-members or Community organisations for services to Scouting or the Community
