

# RIDDLES ON THE ROCKS

## Getting Started...

### Plan

- Talk to the six about riddles that they have seen and if they solved any riddles
- Set up a riddles and puzzles night
- The sixes set riddles and puzzles for each other

### Do

- The six should try to pick riddles and puzzles that are done in teams so that the sixes have to work as teams.
- At the end of the evening the sixes should share the answers with the other sixes so that they know if they were right.

### Review

- As a Pack, have a chat about how each six got on and what they thought of the riddles and puzzles
- Ask them to see what areas they were best at and what areas they'd like to look at again
