The World Scout Moot is a unique event (occurring every 4 years) for young people aged 18 – 26 years from across the world to come together to experience Scouting and explore new challenges.

In 2021, this is being hosted in Ireland from 19th – 28th July 2021.

What does the role of Head of Contingent entail?

The HoC is mainly responsible for the planning and organising of the Scouting Ireland Contingent before, during and after the World Scout Moot. He/she will work with Scouting Ireland's departments of finance, operations and communications in order to achieve the organisation's successful participation in the event. He/she will also be accountable to the Board of Directors of Scouting Ireland via the appropriate sub-structure. Please note: the first HoC weekend is being held 5th – 7th July 2019 in Dublin.
