Terms of Office

The term of the Communications Team shall run concurrent to the term of office of the Communications Commissioner subject to Rule 127.

Members to serve concurrently with the Communications Commissioner and must vacate the team on the appointment of a new Communications Commissioner. On the resignation of the Communications Commissioner in midterm the team will remain in place until a new Communication's Commissioner is appointed. Existing Members can be reappointed by the NMC on the proposal of the next Communications Commissioner.

- News Team

Members of the Communications Team

The Communications team shall consist of the following:

- Other Communications team members to be appointed by the NMC on the proposal of the Communications Commissioner.
- The Communications Commissioner will endeavor to have at least one member of the team from each Province.
