Scouting Ireland - The International Team – Terms of Reference				

Terms of Office

The term of the International Team shall run concurrent to the term of office of the International Commissioner subject to Rule 127.

Members to serve concurrently with the International Commissioner and must vacate the team on the appointment of a new International Commissioner. On the resignation of the International Commissioner in midterm the team will remain in place until a new International Commissioner is appointed. Existing Members can be reappointed by the NMC on the proposal of the next International Commissioner.

The International Commissioner will assign members of the team to the following areas.

- Provincial, County & Group Support
- Annual Camps Abroad
- Development Education
- Jamboree Support
- Incoming Visitors

Functions and Roles

The functions of the International Team shall include the co-ordination of all the International aspects of Scouting Ireland in the following areas;

- Groups Travelling Abroad
- Foreign Scouts visiting Ireland
- Scouting Ireland personnel on European/World Committee

- International Event Participation

Members of the International Team

The International Team shall consist of the following:

- The International Commissioner;
- Provincial International Coordinator as appointed by the Provincial Commissioner;
- The representatives to the National Youth Programme Committee and the National Adult Resources Committee;
- Two representatives of each National Youth Forum.
- Up to three others as may be appointed by the National Management Committee as recommended by the International Commissioner.
