- Camp Chief – World Scout Moot 2021

The World Scout Moot is an official event of the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). It is specifically designed for young people aged between 18 and 25 years inclusive, from National Scout Organizations that are members of WOSM. The World Scout Moot is held every four years and is each time organized by a National Scout Organization appointed by the World Scout Conference, under the supervision of the World Scout Committee and with the support of the World Scout Committee and the World Scout Bureau. The 16th World Scout Moot in 2021 is being hosted and organized by Scouting Ireland.

The Camp Chief will be a volunteer appointed by Scouting Ireland and will Lead the delivery of a world-class international and intercultural learning opportunity through the hosting of the World Scout Moot across the island of Ireland in 2021 in accordance with policies of WOSM.

Summary of Role:

Lead and manage the delivery of a world-class international and intercultural learning opportunity through the hosting of the World Scout Moot across the island of Ireland in 2021 in accordance with policies of WOSM.

Principal Deliverables:

- Leading & motivating a volunteer team to deliver the event whilst forming a strong bond of friendship and support.
- Embed a culture of trust, awareness, inclusivity, appreciation and respect for others.

Principal Accountabilities:

- Lead and manage the delivery of the World Scout Moot in 2021 in Ireland.
- Ensure the delivery of the event in a financially viable manner, contributing to a lasting legacy to Scouting Ireland and to World Scouting.
- Ensure the identification of all pertinent risks in connection with the delivery of the event and develop strategies for appropriate management, mitigation and or/risk acceptance.
- Ensure the delivery of the infrastructure for the event using the appropriate resources, eg. sites and facilities, event equipment, environment, health and safety requirements and transport.
- Promote Scouting in Ireland and inspire young people to attend and support the Moot.
- Support the development, embedding and adherence to relevant governance and structures to facilitate accountability in management and oversight, providing separation of both.
- Provide regular status reports to WOSM and Scouting Ireland
- Lead and coordinate the WSM planning team, other volunteers and IST.
- Ensure the delivery of an inspiring, educational, informative and inclusive programme to participants and IST.
- Ensure a smooth transition from the Moot Advanced Planning team.
- Appoint a Deputy Camp Chief and appoint two people to lead each stream of the Moot Planning Team.

Essential Criteria / Experience Required:

- Relevant management qualification – minimum QQI Level 6 or NCF Level 4 / 5 or equivalent.
- Personal commitment required to take on and dedicate themselves to this extensive and challenging task for the next 4 years.
- Membership of Scouting Ireland in accordance with the Rules or willing and able to become a member.
- Knowledge and understanding of the relevant aims and policies of WOSM in relation to world events.
- Demonstrates an ability to discharge the key areas of responsibility and delegate accountability appropriately.
- Understands the need to and demonstrates an ability to work under physical and intellectual pressure and in a demanding environment.
