



ON MY HONOUR (Living the Cub Scout Promise)



Activity Summary

This activity is both an individual and Pack activity. Each Cub Scout should live the Cub Scout Promise and document their good deeds or random acts of kindness for the week of the 12th – 18th of November. The Cub Scouters should do likewise so as to provide reinforcement for the youth members that the Promise is a code of living and not just meaningless words.

During that same week, the Pack must serve their community in a collective act or deed.

Rationale

The Cub Scout Promise is the pledge that each Cub Scout makes upon investiture in which they show that they understand the Cub Scout Law and that they intend to do their best to keep it through works and actions. They promise to make the world a better place by helping others. Scouters should emphasise that a good turn or random act of kindness is something which is done voluntarily and that the Cub should not expect anything in return.

No matter if they are in uniform or not, they are still Cub Scouts.

The Law should be part of everyday life for a Cub Scout.
