



Jamboree - participant and staff opportunities

At some stage in every Scout's Scouting career they should attend a jamboree.

There is always a jamboree happening somewhere in the world every year, so it could be your annual expedition.

The pinnacle of jamborees is the World Scout Jamboree - this is held every four years. Places are limited (as every country wants to take part) and it can be expensive to attend. While the opportunities are enormous and it will be a life remembered experience, it is also possible to have a similar experience at a smaller jamboree.

The unique feature of a jamboree is the international experience, meeting and sharing activities with Scouts from a host of different countries.

You can also attend a jamboree as a staff member, helping to run services and bases. This is often a good way to meet Venture Scouts as you will be working directly together. It is often easier to get a place as staff member, if there are not many participant places.
